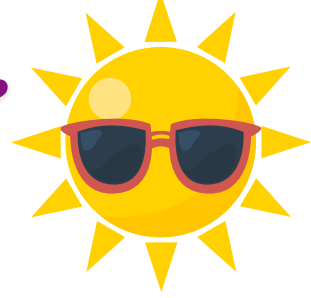




IRONDEQUOIT KINDER CAMP



Location

- All Kinder Camp sessions are located at the Irondequoit Community Center. It is located at 450 Skyview Centre Pkwy, Suite 200.
- **July 16th, July 30th, and Aug. 6th** - Camp will take place at Camp Eastman (1301 Lakeshore Blvd) in the Spies Conference Center. On these days please apply sunscreen to your child, and have them wear a bathing suit under their clothes and bring a towel.

Drop-off and pick up Procedures

- Drop-off and pick-up for Kinder Camp is located at the Irondequoit Community Center in the Game Room. Parents will need to scan or sign into the building.
- If you need to have a late drop off or early pick up during the camp day please call ahead.
- ID and signature is required for pick-up.

Staff

- Our camp staff is composed of a dedicated group of individuals. All camp staff have completed a comprehensive application form, been background checked, are interviewed by Camp Supervisory Staff, and are chosen based on their experience, leadership skills and ability to relate to children. They are trained in creative programming, group games, child development, conflict resolutions, safety procedures and more.

Behavior

In keeping with our program goals, we encourage fun for all of our participants. However, certain rules are necessary to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment. Participants are expected to:

- Show respect for all participants and staff.
- Refrain from using foul language.
- Refrain from causing bodily harm to other participants or staff.
- Respect all equipment, supplies, and facilities.
- Recreation reserves the right to suspend a participant for inappropriate behavior or for safety reasons.

Medications

- Our camp staff not allowed to administer medications. Camper's are allowed to self-carry Epi-Pens
- and Inhalers. Any medication (both prescription and over-the-counter) needing to be dispensed at camp will need to have a parent/guardian administer.



Immunization History

- New York State Department of Health requires each camp to keep a current copy of every camper's Immunization history on file in order for them to attend.

Emergencies



- Our staff is professionally trained in CPR, First Aid and how to handle a variety of emergency situations. In the event of an emergency, we will notify parents/emergency contact immediately. If necessary, ambulance transportation will be handled by local first responders.



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Sick Child Policy

- Please do not send your child to camp if he/she is sick and/or running a fever. If a child becomes ill during camp, a parent or authorized pick-up will be contacted to pick-up the child. Children must be fever free for at least 24 hrs. before returning. A doctor's note may be required for your child to return to camp.



Camper T-Shirt

- Each registered camper will receive a summer camp t-shirt as part of their registration. Camp t-shirts will be distributed to each camper on the first day of each session.



Photo Policy

- Occasionally, photos may be taken of participants in the programs, classes, and activities, or of people in the Town's parks. Please note that these photos may be used in future brochures, website, pamphlets, flyers, or news releases. Please let us know if your child cannot be photographed.

Lost and Found

- **Please make sure to label all belongings.** The Town of Irondequoit is not responsible for lost, stolen, broken, or destroyed items. Please leave all valuables at home.
