- Participants at Colebrook and Rogers locations will need to bring their own non-perishable lunch daily.

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Staff

- Our camp staff is composed of a dedicated group of individuals. All camp staff have completed a comprehensive application form, been background checked, are interviewed by Camp Supervisory Staff, and are chosen based on their experience, leadership skills and ability to relate to children. They are trained in creative programming, group games, child development, conflict resolutions, safety procedures and more.

Behavior Policy

In keeping with our program goals, we encourage fun for all of our participants. However, certain rules are necessary to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment. Participants are expected to:

- Recreation reserves the right to suspend a participant for inappropriate behavior or for safety reasons.

Sunscreen

Campers should apply sunscreen before arriving at camp. If camper brings sunscreen with them they will need to self apply. Counselors are able to assist with spray sunscreen only.

Sick Child Policy

Please do not send your child to camp if he/she is sick and/or running a fever. If a child becomes ill during camp, a parent or authorized pick-up will be contacted to pick-up the child. Children must be fever free for at least 24 hrs. before returning. A doctor's note may be required for your child to return to camp.



Rainy Days

Camp will run scheduled times regardless of the weather. We have rainy day activities prepared of games, and crafts on days when the weather is too rainy to be outside. When the weather is inclement the campers participate in activities in the gymnasium, cafeteria and classroom.



Photo Policy

- Occasionally, photos may be taken of participants in the programs, classes, and activities, or of people in the Town's parks. Please note that these photos may be used in future brochures, website, pamphlets, flyers, or news releases. Please let us know if your child cannot be photographed.



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Camp Inspection

- Our Summer Camps are licensed by and inspected by the Monroe County Department of Health as per Chapter 1 of the State Sanitary Code, Subpart 7.2 Children's Day Camps. Said regulations of this code may be examined at the Irondequoit Community Center, 450 Skyview Centre Pkwy., Suite 200 during regular office hours. Site inspection reports are also on file.



Medication

- Our camp staff not allowed to administer medications. Camper's are allowed to self-carry Epi-Pens and Inhalers. Any medication (both prescription and over-the-counter) needing to be dispensed at camp will need to have a parent/guardian administer.



Immunization History

New York State Department of Health requires each camp to keep a current copy of every camper's immunization history on file in order for them to attend.

Emergencies



- Our staff is professionally trained in CPR, First Aid and how to handle a variety of emergency situations. In the event of an emergency, we will notify parents/emergency contact immediately. If necessary, ambulance transportation will be handled by local first responders.

Lost and Found



- Please make sure to label all belongings.** The Town of Irondequoit is not responsible for lost, stolen, broken, or destroyed items. Please leave all valuables at home. The lost and found is located at the playground site. Lost and found items will be disposed of after the completion of the last summer camp session.

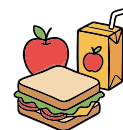
